REGISTRATION

Can I register the day of the race?

Yes, as long as space is still available. The cost of registration will increase to \$60 per team on the day of the race.

I've registered online, now what?

Get excited! Be on the lookout for emails about check-in and any additional race details.

I'm registered, but I (or my teammate) can't make it to the race?

Is there an age limit to participate?

We welcome all ages; however, racers under 18 must have signed parental consent. Any participants under the age of 15 must race with a parent or guardian.

How do the challenge stations work?

Each location will have a challenge. All challenges will involve both members of the team and can be mental, physical or just silly.

How do you determine the winner of the race?

Winners will be determined based on number of points received at each challenge and for other factors, including overall race time. If two teams accumulate the same number of points, the winner will be determined by the fastest time.

Do I have to be really athletic to compete?

Nope, this is about fun! The challenges are a mix of physical, mental and creativity. This race is designed to be completed by all levels.

What is your refund policy?

There is no refund policy, however, you can transfer your registration to another racer by notifying the proper race officials.

DAY OF THE RACE

Is transportation needed?

Yes. Teams will travel between designated parking areas.

What time should I arrive on event day?

Check-in is from 7:30-8:30 AM at the Tallahassee Food Truck Court at 725 S Bronough St. (Gaines And Madison). You must check-in prior to 8:30 AM AND attend the mandatory team meeting at 8:45 AM. ALL RACERS MUST CHECK IN.

Will I have a map?

Yes, a general area map will be provided to show the boundaries of the race; however, the locations of every stop may not be indicated.

Can I use technology?

Players are welcome to use their smartphones to look up information. Additionally, extra points may be earned at designated Selfie Spots along the course by posting specific information to pre-identified social media channels.

What will I need to bring?

At least one racer must have a charged smartphone. This phone must have access to social media accounts and a functional camera. You may also want to have a bag to carry water, snacks etc. but this is not required.

What should I wear?

We suggest wearing comfortable athletic shoes, as some challenges will be physical in nature. Racers are also encouraged to dress in team "uniforms," however that may be interpreted. Note: These uniforms must not impede or endanger participants or facilitators.

What are challenges?

Racers will not know what the challenges are until they arrive at the challenge location.

What is the course? How will I know where to go?

You will receive a general map of the area and clues to help you find your way to each location.

Do I need a digital camera?

You must have one phone per team that is capable of taking and sending photos.

How can I travel to checkpoints?

Yes. Teams will travel between designated parking areas.

How long will the race last?

The race will last approximately 3-4 hours, although winning teams will most likely finish faster. When the course closes at 12 PM, challenge locations will shut down and send all racers back to Food Truck Court for the awards and celebration.

What if I can't find a checkpoint or I get lost?

Once your team has exhausted all hope of figuring out the intended location or a team feels they are lost, a racer can call the "Help Line" located on the map. The Help Line will provide directions, and a time penalty will be added to that team's final calculation.
